

A. Journal of a Whaling Voyage in the  
Ship Plover, in the Indian Ocean A. N. Perkins  
Master Sailed June 22<sup>d</sup>. 1858.

Abk. Sail. Tuesday, June 22<sup>d</sup>. 1858  
Remarks On board, at 9. A. M. all hands  
on board, got under way for sea, with a  
light air from the South with all sail set.  
So Ends these 24 hours beating out of the bay.

Fitting Boats. Wednesday, June 23<sup>d</sup>. 1858  
Sailed with a light breeze from South to S.W.  
and pleasant under all sail, at 6. P. M. choosed  
watches, at 10. 15. P. M. the Pilot left us, 107  
Head bearing S. E. 12. miles dist. tacked several  
times during the night, the wind S. S. W. to  
W. S. W. and light, at 3. A. M. tacked, ships  
headed up S. S. W. latter part light breeze  
and pleasant, stowed the Anchors, unshent  
the chains and stowed them below, so Ends.  
all hands fitting the Boats. Lat by Obs. 40. 53. N.

Fitting Boats. Thursday, June 24<sup>th</sup>. 1858  
Sailed with a gentle breeze from the S. S. W.  
and fine weather, under all sail stered S. E.  
and S. E. by S. coiled the boats lines, saw two  
sails, at 10. P. M. furled the royals, middle  
part brisk breeze, at 5. A. M. furled the  
top gallant sails and Flying Sitt, latter  
part strong breeze, so Ends, the watch fitting  
the Boats. Lat by Obs. 38. 24. N. Long by Obs. 67. 41. W.

Fitting Boats. Friday June 25<sup>th</sup>. 1858  
Sailed with a strong breeze from the S. W. by S.  
and cloudy, stering S. E. by E. Main top g.  
sail and Flying Sitt out, at 5. P. M. took  
in the light sails, saw two sails, at 8. 30.  
reefed the Fore & Mizzen top sails, at 12. P. M.  
stered S. E. middle part rainey, latter strong  
breeze and cloudy, so Ends, the watch fitting  
the Boats. Lat by Obs. 37. 30. N. Long by Obs. 63. 25. W.
