Remarks on Board of the President

June the 1 1843
At these 24 hours commence with
fresh winds from the S^W at 7 P.M.
hove up the anchor and went to
sea later part paper with fresh
winds accompanied with light
squalls of rain from the Westward
course S by W all hands employed
in various jobs of ships duty &c
Sounded these 24 hours

June the 2 1843
These 24 hours commence with fresh winds
& clear mether from the S^W course S & E
the middle and latter part paper with
moderate breezes from the S^W all
hands employed in various jobs of ships
duty &c Sounded these 24 hours

Saturday June the 3
The first part of these 24 hours paper
with moderate breezes and cloudy mether
from the southward middle & latter part
paper with fresh winds and clear from
the S E by S steering to the Eastward
all hands employed in ships duty &c

June the 4 1843
The first part of these 24 hours paper
with mild mether and light winds from
southward & Eastward all hands making
out &c latter part paper with fresh winds
accompanied with light squalls of rain
from the southward steering to the Eastward
Sounded
