Passage From Nantucket To Fayal
 Friday July 31 1835
 August 1 1835

1st first part strong breezes from S S W course E
 middle part squally at 4 P.M. called all hands &
 double reefed the topsails and hoisted the boats
 to the davits heads wind about W course E
 latter part moderate made all sail made

Saturday Sat Long
 1st first part strong breezes S W course E by S
 saw two Brigs steering E by S middle part wind
 halled W by S latter part made more moderate
 with more rain winds

Sunday Sat Long
 2nd first part light wind from W course E & E middle
 the same latter halled to E by E steering E by S
 sound Sat 39.53 Long 43 by Ches 44 by 48 Chro

Monday
 3rd first part light breeze fresh S by E steering
 Capt etc in part 4 spoke the Royal William
 St Andrews Capt Fisher 16 days out bound
 to the Falkland Islands a whaling middle part
 pleasant latter part strong breeze from S
 heading E & E all hands employed in breaking
 out and stowing, rear and building a potato
 house on deck sound Sat 40 25

Tuesday first part Long 40 23
 4th strong breezes from S heading
 E by S at 6 P.M. finished the potatoes from
 and stowing the rear middle and latter part
 pleasant at 10 P.M. saw a school of large
 whales at 11 part 11 lowered and fastened and
 within a short time blood and rawed winds
