Congress Zetta and Anadromus Lyngsoff are on
except the latter came to anchor round

Tuesday first part pleasant weather strong breeze

18 Southward the Captain cannon fired and hoisted
the larboard anchor which was paid in then
it came alive to the John Adams' quarters and
then took up the starboard anchor was being to
near the ice shore without our assistance
the Capt took up the anchor and went ashore
and at 2 P.M. returned on board again and under
the sail made light sail and sailing
employed in hoisting out of the 11 sails at
about the 11 point in P.M. here E wind
and W latter all hands employed in various
repairs

recruits at 11 P.M. speak the Congress
in company with the John Adams and Zetta

24 first part strong breeze from E S E
course by W middle in company with the

middle part moderate latter more moderate
made all sail course by W middle E
middle Sat 35 50 Long 26 30

Tuesday first part strong breeze E by N course

25 by W middle break out the after haul
got out 11 sails of mackerel 25 repacked
them middle part more moderate squally
latter more moderate middle Sat 25 08

26 breeze from E N E course by W middle
and latter the same at 11 P.M. all closed down
the fore and main topmast hauled up the main
and fished the main topmast sail to set
the Congress down in the main line set of
the topmast back stays at 11 P.M. the sails
up and were made sail round Sat 21 58
