BAHAMA BANK, HOLE IN THE WALL, &c.

[That patrons should not consider our publications as mere copies, or that we are in any way remiss in our duty to the community, we briefly state the improvements made in this Chart, over any now extant, viz:—1. It commences 1° farther north, and extends to Havana, with a PLAN of that Harbour, and description of the Light House lately erected on Moro Castle.—2. A correct VIEW, showing the appearance of the Hole-in-the-Wall.—3. Sailing directions for crossing the Bank.—4. Between one and two hundred Soundings taken on the Bank, some late as July, 1818.—5. Tracks over Salt Key Bank.—6. Directions for anchoring, &c. when passing through the Gulf, and you meet a gale from the northward.—7. Position of the Light House lately erected on Hog Island at the entrance of Nassau, (New-Providence)—8. Tide on the Banks.]
