

Tuesday 9mo 15 Commences with fresh breeze from the S.W. first part pleasant later part strong breeze with some rain At 10 AM at Sea and Shields saw a ship standing to the Eastward

Wednesday 9mo 16 All the 24 hours strong gales from S.W. first and latter part pleasant - all hands engaged in putting ship in order Long 41 G.

Thursday 9mo 17 All these 24 hours fresh breeze from the W. and pleasant middle and latter part equally: lower double reefed topsails main sail and jib hauled. Wind S.W. Course S.E. by E.

Friday 9mo 18 Commences with fresh breeze from N.E. and rainy middle part equally latter part pleasant all sail set went from N.E. Course E.S.E.

Saturday 9mo 19 Commences with fresh breeze from N.W. and pleasant middle part calm later part strong Breeze from the W. Course S.E. by E.

Sunday 9mo 20 Commences with pleasant weather and fresh breeze from the N.W. At 11 AM ^{land} which proved to be Thora & Carvo Middle & latter part pleasant. Course S.E. Long 39.42, Song 31.41

Monday 9mo 21 All these 24 hours moderate breeze from N.W. and pleasant weather Saw Black Fish and lowered away in pursuit but without success Course E.N.E. Long 39.2

Tuesday 9mo 22 Commences with fresh breeze from the W. Middle and latter part pleasant Saw 2 sperm whales lowered away J.P. & W.ist D and took one to the Starboard Boat which made us 70 barrels ^{ruled by Mr Burgess}

Wednesday 9mo 23 All these 24 hours fresh breeze from the N.W. All hands engaged at cutting in this whale finished at 10 AM. ~~lost~~ ^{short some} the catch ^{short some}

Thursday 9mo 24 All these 24 hours light breeze from the S.W. and pleasant all hands employed in boiling several sail in light saw a whale a lurching with 20 boats in chase

Friday 9mo 25 All these 24 hours light breeze from S.W. and pleasant All hands boiling and Coopering Oil. Saturday 9mo 26 All these 24 hours light breeze from S.W. and pleasant Starboard boat went ashore at St. Marys and got Potatoes and Apples

Sunday 9mo 27 All these 24 hours light breeze from the West and pleasant saw whales but they escaped to windward there was 5 other sail in Chase 4 Bays 1 Ship

Monday 28 of 9mo Commences with fresh breeze from the N.W. and cloudy middle part heavy gales at 9 P.M. jib set fore and main topsails latter part calm gamed with Brig Mexico

Tuesday 9mo 29 Commences with light breeze from N.W. and rainy middle sail in company with several brig middle and latter part winds south west and rainy the S.W. part of Sarah bearing S.W. dist 2 miles

Wednesday 9mo 30 Commences with calm all hands employed at making sail middle and latter part fresh breeze from the S.W. and pleasant at 5 P.M. raised whale and lowered the fastener and lowered raised by J. Hayes

Thursday 10mo 1 Commences with calm and pleasant weather middle and latter part fresh breeze from the N.W. the ship under double reefed topsails and course

Friday Oct 2d Commences with fresh Gales from N.W. and pleasant beating up between the Islands of Graciosa and St. George middle & latter part the same

Saturday 10mo 3 Commences with fresh breeze from the N. and cloudy middle & latter part pleasant at 10 AM. lowered the Cape at Sayal at 1 P.M. took him on board and at 5 P.M. took 10 bushels of Potatoes on board and landed our Oil

Sunday Oct 4th. These 24 hours commences with strong wind from N.W. with clear weather standing off and on at Sayal - at 2 P.M. Capt came on board, made sail and squared away steering S.W. by Compass middle and latter part wind and weather same all hands engaged at sundy jobs thus ends all
