Islands in the ship command of New Bedford
and begin to give the Indian Ocean to the
capt. de Anckeroy. kept by A. C. Miller

July 15th 1795 Wednesday the day commences with fine weather
returns from 10 AM pilot called all hands to haul
up the boat set water men and crew out the day
at 12 o'clock Mexican cap. Brooker came on board with the
pilot and went to sea steering. Side board this day

Thursday July 16th the day commences with fine breeze all hands
employed at stowing the stores and cables. Fine morning and
evening with fine weather steering 50° at 5 AM regular ahead

Friday July 17th the day commences with fine weather at 4 PM
business kept out the harbor all hands employed at fitting
the boat to enter this day

Saturday July 18th the day commences with fine weather and
calm all hands employed at ships duty. Little fast light
winds from west steering 50° at 5 AM
