July 25

Pleasant breeze from the SSW
at 1 P M Come to anchor
with the small boat on board
and the Sth E. side of Providence
Lake part employed in
sundry jobs on the Regge

July 26

Begins with pleasant breeze
from the SW get under way
and beat out to sea
at half past 8 P M
Crew part light house
Bore S W 1/2 S 1/2 miles
through the night
Nothing remarkable

July 27

Lat 38 N = 19 S.
Long by account 71 W
Begins with fine breeze from
the S W steering to the S Eward
by the wind at 3 P M shake the ship
