from Liverpool bound to Philadelphia with passengers
at 4 P M single reefed top sail
took in the main sail
at 4 P M set the main sail
at 9 A M kept of S by S
Wind WSW several of the
Crew sea sick
Lat by account 49-00 N
the Sun observed Long by Ac
69-13 W

Monday 18

through the day pleasant weather &
fine breeze from the S W wind
steering S by S all sail set to
the best advantage
at 7 A M saw black fish &
per posses Employed in putting the
boats and Craft &c &c
No obs - Long by account
6 1/2 = 31 W

Tuesday 19

July 1828
Begins with strong breeze
which brought us under
double reefed top sails
and caused us to take in the
Waist Boat
middle part to Wind at
SW by W latter part more
moderate took out on
Reef out each top sail
and set the main top of sail
how ever so Rugged that
I kept S by S
Lat obs 39-45 N
and Long by account 61-30 W

Wednesday 20

Begins with strong breeze
from the S W wind
halled up S by S
Employed in Sundry jobs
middle and latter part more moderate
made all sail Wind S W by W
all hands Employed in putting the
Boats and jobs on the Reggin
N Correct Lat Long by account 46
