weather of Ship heading N.W. by N
Lighted nothing remarkable Lucas in
sight

These 24 hours light breezes at the

Lighted a Schooner Steering to the
North Employed in painting
thus ends Lucas in sight

Tuesday April 5 1836

First part of these 24 hours pleasant
breezes at the west Ship heading N.W.
Middle and latter part strong breezes at
the S.W. Ship heading N.W. by North to
Ends these 24 hours Lucas in company

Wednesday April 6 1836

First part of these 24 hours fresh breezes
