

Thursday April the 7 1836

First part Light breezes at
N.W. at 3 P.M. wind shifted to W.S.W.
tack Ship and heading N.W. & N. at
wind shifted to the North in a Squall
Middle part Strong Gales at N.E. & W.
Ship heading to the westward under
Main topsails and Staysails Latter part
Strong Gales reef the fore sail and set
it also fore and main topsail thus
Ends this day

Lat. in 32.36 N.
Long in 71.50 W

Friday April 8 1836

First part of these 24 Strong Gales
at the North Ship heading W.N.W. under
Short Sail Middle part more moderate
Ship heading N.W. Latter part fine weather
and moderate breezes at the eastward
at 11 A.M. sighted sperm whales going quick
to the N.E. Lowered in company with Ship
Lucas at Meridian Chasing sighted one
Sail thus Ends Lat. in 33.01
Long in 73.00

Saturday April 9 1836

Commenced with Light breezes at the Eastward
at 3 P.M. came on board the whale going
to Duck to come up with them Latter
part fresh breezes at the S.E. & W. Ship heading
N.W. the temperature of the water 74
thus Ends Lucas in company
and a sail Steer N.W.

Lat. in 34.19
Long in 74.15

Sunday April 10 1836

First part of these 24 hours fresh breezes
at S.E. & W. Ship heading N.W. & W. till 7 then
Steered N.E. & E. at 12 Coolened the water
Steered N.W. Latter part fresh breezes at
S.E. & W. sighted 3 Sail thus Ends Lucas in
sight

Lat. in 37.18
Long in 73.10

Monday April 11 1836

Commenced with Strong breezes at S.E. & W.
at 4 P.M. the wind shifted in a Squall
to the North Middle and Latter part
Strong breezes at the North Ship heading
E.N.E. thus sighted 2 Sail Lucas in sight

Lat. 37.48
Long 72.06

Tuesday April 12 1836

All these 24 hours fresh breezes at the
North at 5 P.M. tacked and headed
W.N.W. sighted 2 Ships one working to
windward the other Steer S.E. & W.
at 6 A.M. tacked and heading E.N.E.
sighted nothing but Lucas thus Ends

Lat. in 38.03
Long in 72.15

Wednesday April 13 1836

First part of these 24 hours light breezes
at N.E. Middle part from S.E. Ship heading
N.E. & E. Latter part fresh breezes at S.E.
and cloudy weather thus Ends sighted several
Sail Lucas in sight Lat. in 39.30
Long in 71.48
