Commenced with fresh breezes at west  
Ship heading E. by S. Sighted Blackfish  
Latter took some Middle part fresh  
breezes at N.W. and Squally with the  
top sails furled the Main sail Latter  
part more moderate Sighted a  
Ship Steering E. by N. thus Ends  
Lat. 41.09  
Long 49.30

Sunday  
August  
20<sup>th</sup>

These 24 hours strong breezes at  
N.W. by N Ship heading E. by E. Sighted  
2 Ships heading East one to the west  
thus Ends  
Lat. in 40.43  
Long in 45.20

Monday  
August  
21

Commenced with strong breezes at N.W.  
Ship heading S.E. by E. by compass middle  
and latter rather more moderate Sighted  
a Barque Ship Steering S.W. thus Ends  
Lat. in 40.20  
Long in 41.40

Tuesday  
August  
22

Commenced with strong breezes  
at N.W. Ship heading E. by E.  
Middle part more moderate  
Latter part strong breezes at North  
thus Ends  
Lat. in 39.59  
Long in 38.15

Wednesday  
August  
23<sup>rd</sup>

Commenced with strong breezes  
at the North Sighted a Brig heading  
East Middle part strong breezes and  
Squally Latter part the Same thus  
Ends  
Lat. in 39.59 N  
Long in 35.10 W.

Thursday  
August  
24<sup>th</sup>

All these 24 hours strong breezes and  
Squally wind from N.W. to N.N.E.  
Ship heading E. by E. to S.E. Sighted  
nothing thus Ends  
Lat. in 39.15  
Long by G. 31.20

Friday  
August  
25<sup>th</sup>

Commenced with strong breezes at  
North. Ship heading S.E. by E. at 2.30 P.M.  
Sighted Flores bearing East by compass  
Dis 20 miles at sunset bearing  
N.E. Ship Steering for Fayall Middle  
and latter part squally Employed  
Setting up rigging thus Ends  
Lat 38.35  
Long. 29.00

Saturday  
August  
26

Commenced with strong breezes  
and Squally at 1 P.M. Sighted  
Fayal bearing S.E. by E. at 4 P.M.  
went on Shore at the harbor  
at 7 returned could not obtain  
any necessaries until a change  
of weather Latter Squally and  
fresh breezes ship running down  
the S. of Pico Sighted several  
Sail thus Ends

Sept. 5<sup>th</sup>

N.E. Ship heading S.W. Middle and  
Latter part the Same Sighted 3 Sail  
bearing S.W. Pacific in sight  
thus Ends  
Lat. in 25.55 N  
Long in 21.30 W.
