Long in 24.20 W

Sunday
Sept. 3 - 1837

Commenced with gentle breezes
at the Eastward Ship heading
South by compass Middle and
latter part the same sighted no
whales thus Ends Lat. in 31.56
Long in 22.30

25
Monday
Sept. 4

Commenced with brisk winds and fine weather
Ship heading S.W. by compass Middle and
latter part the same sighted nothing thus
concludes Pacific in sight at in 29.11 N
Long in 22.00 West

26
Tuesday
Sept. 5th

Commenced with fresh trade at
N.E. Ship heading S.W. Middle and
latter part the same sighted 3 Sail
bearing S.W. Pacific in sight
thus Ends
Lat. in 25.55 N
Long in 21.30 W
