the Mornings that Cheep up a head sea we
being Bound to the Northward Paul Slept
considerable last Night & Seamer More Rational
to Day But Raises Blood Lat^{ty} by 013 37.55

24th fine Weather wind easterly in fore
Part Paul Appears something Better we
hew out some Cheeks for our Booms in hopes
if Paul mend, will Not to go Home in latter
Part of wind Veard Round to the Southward
Lat^{ty} by 013 39.05

25 being first Day of the week fine Weather
Wind Southerly at 8 o'clock ante Mer. Sounded
& had 45 fathoms Water in Blockstrand Chanel
at Mr. had 57 fathoms on N E Course at 2 o'clock
had 32 fathoms at 4 o'clock P. Mr. had 28 fathoms
in fore. Chanel at 5 o'clock we saw Romans
Land at Sun Set Got within a League at 8 o'clock
Got a Brest with Gay head and at 11 o'clock at
Night Came to an anchor in homes hole the Wind
at S W. Lat^{ty} by 013 40.20

26th ~~1762~~ in the Morning heft up & Run for
4th Nantucket Got a Ground on Tucker
Shoal & by there an hour & half a Done
O'clock Got into Nantucket Got our Goose
Neck Mended & Racked our Mast
& Carried up Paulswains fild upon water
& Got it on board

27 Got Ready to sail but could not get a
hand to sail

28th Got sail for the Vineyard Got in to Holmes
hole in y Evening Saw the wood on fire upon
the Neck or West Chop

29 when Got up in the Morning Saw the Chimney
of Baxters House standing & the house burnt
& Down went to Shore to try to get a hand But
could get Not one to Day

30 being Loth to go out a hand short I sent
Timothy Merry in Quest of one just a Night
one Came Down of his own accord I ship him went
on board heft up the Run up to Gay head to get his
on board
