

Remarks on board Barque Dapple

Tuesday Nov 14-1854

First part fresh gales from S.W. by S steering E. At 10 in sight. Mended the main topgallant sail & bent it. At 4 o'clock hauled by the wind to S.E. Middle part heading S.E. Latter part at day light made sail. At 7 o'clock were ship to W. by S. A sail in sight.

Lat by Obs 100° 05' Long by Chr 81-50 W

Wednesday Nov 15-1854

First part fresh gales from S.W. heading N.W. Middle part heading N. Latter part at day light were ship to S.E. 2 sails in sight. Saw three backs.

Thursday Nov 16-1854

First part fresh gales from S.W. heading S.E. At sun down shorten sail. Middle part heading N.E. Latter part at day light made sail. At 4 o'clock were ship to W. by S.

Lat by Obs 104° 48' Long by Chr 81-45 W

Friday Nov 17-1854

First part light gales from S.W. by W heading W. by S. A sail in sight. Middle part at 3 o'clock were ship to S.E. Latter part Put Trenchy in the riggin and gave him a dozen for taking a belaying to the Captain and refusing his orders. Good.

Cruising for Sperm Whales

Monday Nov 18-1854

First part light gales from S.W. heading N.E. At sun down shorten sail. Middle part heading S.E. Latter part at day light made sail. At 7 o'clock were ship to W. by S. 2 sails in sight.

Lat by Obs 100-44 W Long by Chr 81-44 W

Tuesday Nov 19-1854

First part light gales from S.W. At 1 o'clock saw a Barque among whales hauled the boats and went after them. But could not get near them. At 5 o'clock came on board. At 6 o'clock spoke the Sea breeze. At gun down shorten sail. Middle part at 12 o'clock were ship to W. by S. Latter part at day light made sail heading N.W. by W.

Lat by Obs 1-10 W Long by Chr 82-33 W



Monday Nov 20-1854

First part light gales from S.W. heading N.W. by W. At 6 o'clock shorten sail and were ship to S.E. by S and spoke the Barque Sea breeze Capt. Lushmore is sick. Middle part heading N.E. Latter part at day light made sail - heavy weather heading S.E.
