Saturday First part of this 24 hours fresh breeze from
May 16th N.W. Steering S by E all sail out
Middle part light at 2 of the wind &
Latter part fresh at South 37.18 S by the 31.12

Sunday Commences with fresh breeze from S. took
the 17th in light sails at 6 tucked ship to the S.E.
Middle part heavy squalls took in sail
down to double reef main top sail and fore
Latter part the same set main spruce
at South 37.50 S by the 68.53 W

Monday Commences with a gale from S
the 18th hauled foresail
Middle part heavy rain squalls at 2 of the
wind hauled out of main sail Steering S
Latter part fine weather all sail out
at South 37.30 S by the 67.40 W

Tuesday
the 19th Commences with light breeze and fine weather
from S Steering S by E all drawing sail on
Middle part squally with thunder and lightning
and rain from S.W. to S.E. took in sail
to close reefed topsails at 2 of the wind & set
foresail Steering S
Latter part strong breeze from S.W. Steering
S by E under double reef topsails
Cock sick and of duty
at South 36.34 S by the 66.40 W

Wed the 20th Commences with strong breeze from S.W.
Steering S by E under double reef topsails
Middle part squally
Latter part fine weather
at South 35.51 S by the 65.51 W

Thurs May Commences with moderate breeze and fine
the 21st weather from W.S.W. Steering S by E all sail on
Middle part the same
Latter part light breeze employed in sheathing
the mast and other jobs about deck
at South 32.29 S by the 62.24 W

Fri May Commences with light breeze and fine
the 22nd weather from W Steering S by E all drawing sail on
Middle and latter part the same
at South 35.20 S by the 60.30 W

Sat May Commences with fresh breeze from W.S.W.
the 23rd Steering S by E at 5 P.M. took in topgallant
sails and single reefed the topsails and
hauled the main sail
Middle and latter part the same
saw blackfish
at South 34.50 S by the 57.15 W

Sunday Commences with fresh breeze and hazy
the 24th weather from W.S.W. set main topgallant
sail over single reef topsails saw a
large ship bound to the S.E.
Middle and latter part the same Steering S by E
at South 32.17 S by the 64.50 W

Mon May Commences with fresh breeze and squally
the 25th from S.W. took in fore topgallant sail
Middle and latter part the same
employed in various jobs about deck
at South 33.47 S by the 52.06 W
