

Bark *Shreak* of *Ukapaiosett*  
Tues May Commences with fresh breeze from  
the 26<sup>th</sup> W steering S E Single reef topsails  
and main topgallant sail  
Middle part strong breeze and squally  
took in sail down to last reef topsails  
Latter part moderate set all sail  
The Cook still sick  
at Sea 29.01

Wed May Commences with light breeze and  
the 27<sup>th</sup> Showery from S W steering S E all set out  
Middle and latter part fresh took  
in topgallant sails rose new fore  
topgallant clewlines  
Cook sick and of duty  
at Sea 30.01

Thurs May Commences with fresh breeze and  
the 28<sup>th</sup> cloudy steering S E under whole topsails  
Middle part the same took in sail and  
set boats crew watches at daylight under  
Latter part frequent showers of rain  
wind S W steering by the wind S E

Fri May Commences with fresh breeze and Showery  
the 29<sup>th</sup> from S W heading S E lowered the  
boats to practice the crew  
Middle part light air at daylight made sail  
Latter part the same N E W steering W by S  
employed in fitting rigging  
The Cook still sick and of duty  
at Sea 31.01 at Sea by the 26.15.01

### Cruising

Sat May Commences with light fair weather from  
the 30<sup>th</sup> S W heading by the wind to the westward  
all sail out at 8 took in sail the Stacks  
boat lowered to practice her crew  
at daylight made sail  
Latter part the same from of Saw a Brig  
steering down for us, saw Humphreys  
at 5.15 P

Sun May Commences with light air from S heading  
the 31<sup>st</sup> W by the wind spoke Brig *Falcon* of Salem  
Capt Hobbes 13 months out 320 Tons gamed  
with him until dark saw and signalled  
at French Rock  
Middle part calm at daylight made sail  
Latter part calm the Brig and Bark in sight  
The Cook still sick and of duty  
at Sea 30.01 at Sea by the 22.11.01

Mon June Commences with light air from S E  
the 1<sup>st</sup> heading S by the wind all sail out  
Middle part wind hauled to the S E  
Latter part moderate breeze and fine weather  
heading S by the wind employed in cutting  
the main rigging and making Spungun  
Sail up the fore royal greece  
at Sea 29.01 at Sea by the 22.16.01

Tues June Commences with moderate breeze and fine  
the 2<sup>nd</sup> weather from S E heading S by the wind with  
main topgallant sail out  
Middle part the same took in sail  
Latter part the same from S heading S E  
by the wind all sail out employed in  
cutting the main rigging  
at Sea 30.06 at Sea by the 24.01
