

Remarks on Board Boreas Bark Sloop A Hole 1877

Wednesday Oct 3

This day begins with strong winds from the east north east with cloudy weather ship steering by the wind heading to the southward no sun to day imbrued fishing the boats for whaling a number of ships in sight

Thursday Oct 4

This day begins with strong winds from the south east with cloudy weather ship steering by the wind heading to the north and east under all sail no sun to day imbrued fishing the boats saw a school of black fish

Friday Oct 5

This day begins with strong winds from the north to the north west blowing to a strong gale no sun to day ship steering by the wind heading to the westward under all sail no sun to day imbrued fishing the boats saw a school of black fish

Saturday Oct 6

This day begins with strong north west gale with clear weather ship steering south east no sun to day two ships in sight

Sunday Oct 7

This day begins with a light gale from the north with cloudy weather ship steering south east by north under single reef the sails no sun to day at the school 6 by: returned sperm whaler lowered two boats but with out success
