1870

July 21<sup>st</sup>  
Settled at Honolulu

Arctic Ocean got from Barque Champion of  
 100 lbs of bread containing 188  
 100 lbs of flour 50 9  
 at 2 1/2 lbs to a gallon the price of the Island market  
 price ranging then at the time the gallons  
 of coals to be replaced again at the Island

also one red wax coil of  
 rigging 3 inch rope 20 lbs  
 one cask of black lead 100 lbs  
 made at 35 lbs to be paid for  
 at the Danish Island

Aug 1870

Settled at Honolulu

Arctic Ocean got from Barque Elizabeth  
 script left Blinn  
 3 saw files  
 2 files 2 inches long  
 2 gimlets small size  
 1 brass oil  
 1 small paper of iron tacks  
 1 " paper of letter  
 2 new hand spikes  
 3 small tea spoons puter

Aug 1870

Settled at Honolulu

Arctic Ocean got from Barque Chimbercooker  
 2 small gimlets  
 1 paper of iron tacks large size  
 1 saw file  
 2 brass oil  
 1 large 12 inch file  
 1 half round file 6 inch  
 1 old pole hammer  
 2 white oak Buts

Aug 1870

Arctic Ocean got from Barque Penny left Williams  
 4 knives  
 2 screwers  
 1 small bottle of ink  
 3 white oak Buts

June

Settled at Honolulu

Arctic Ocean got from Barque Black left Fish  
 3 saw files  
 2 iron tea spoons  
 1 small paper of iron tacks  
 1 screw  
 1 Bar of Blacksmith scale

# in the Arctic Ocean A.D. 1870

July 1870

Settled at Honolulu

Arctic Ocean got from Barque John Howland left Williams  
 3 lbs screwers  
 2 lbs of lead

July 1870

Settled at Honolulu

Arctic Ocean got from Barque John Wells left Dean  
 2 copper hings  
 2 screwers  
 1 lbs of lead 7 1/2

June 1870

Settled at Honolulu

Arctic Ocean got from Barque Emily Morgan left Dexter  
 4 pairs of Blankets 4 of a pair

72 00

August 1870

Settled at Honolulu

Arctic Ocean got from Ship John of Honolulu left Thompson  
 1 red sea sea line 45 fathoms to be replaced at the Island with the fall  
 5 split needles  
 2 pairs of straight neck Thompsons for self

These articles charge all to be paid for at the Island next fall as none  
 of them is or has been settled for yet at the date (Aug 18 1870)
