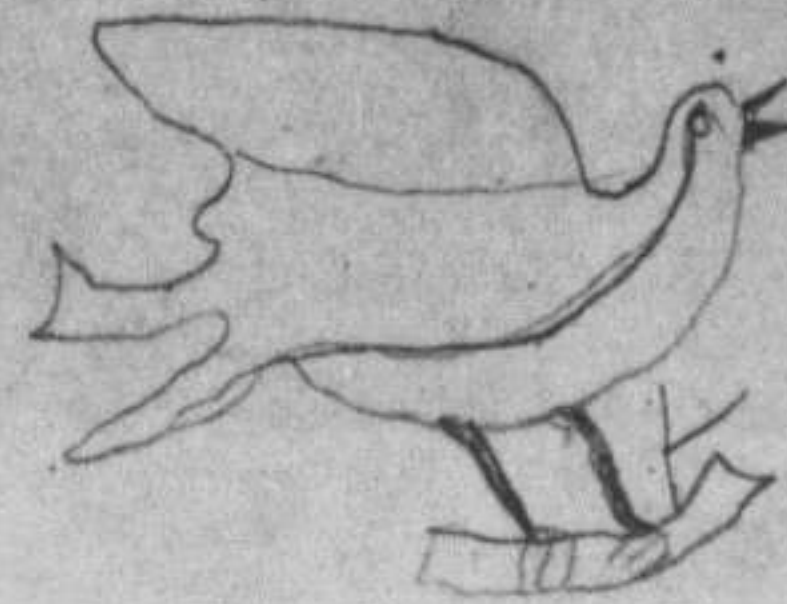
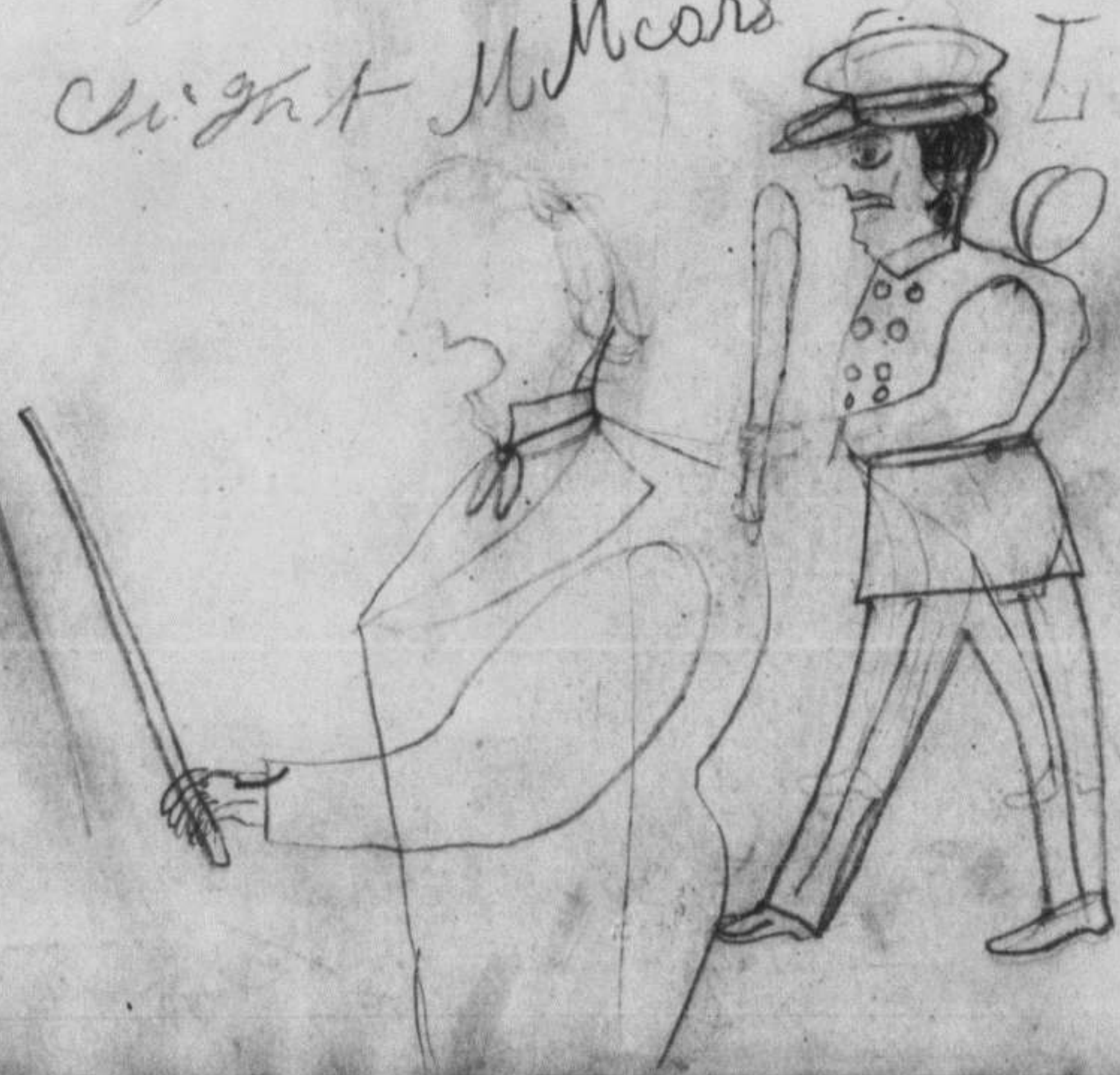


Friday September the 6<sup>th</sup> 1861

 light winds from the West latter part  
 foggy. Sail in sight  
 Lat 40-39 Long 71-20

Sunday the 8<sup>th</sup>  
 begins with light winds from the S.W.  
 and fine weather steering North at 2 P.M.  
 saw the Land Adventure part having  
 North spoke the schooner Joseph Long  
 a days from Philadelphia for West mouth  
 middle part moderate gales from the  
 S.W. steering East at 10 A.M. took  
 pilot from the boat for in 5 barges  
 winds from the S.W. and light sail  
 in sight.
