light westerly winds the Bark steering
E.S.E. Middle and latter part much the
same. Saw a Brig steering to the N.E.

Wednesday Nov 13th This day fresh breeze
from W.S.W. steering E.S.E. under short
sail. Employed breaking out for floor and
breach. Saw nothing of importance.

Thursday Nov 14th Comes in with fine
weather and fresh breezes from the Westward
steering S.E. by E. Middle and latter part
much the same. Saw nothing.
Lat 34.05^N Long 43.19^W

Friday Nov 15th First part of this day comes
in with strong breezes from W.S.W. the Bark steering
S.E. by E. Middle and latter part more moderate.
Saw porpoises. Ends with good weather.
Lat 33.44^N Long by L.R. 40.00^W

from the Westward the Bark steering S.E. by E. Middle
and latter part much the same. Saw nothing of importance.
Employed about ship's duty. Made new fore tacks. Lashed aloft

Sunday Nov 17th This day comes in with fine weather
and moderate breezes from S.W. steering S.E. middle
and latter part much the same. Saw finbacks and saw
our boats for the first time. Ends with fine weather.
Lat 32.46^N Long 34.56^W

the S.E. heading to the Southward. Employed getting the
log works, and sundry stbs. Saw several merchantmen.
Ends with fine weather.
Lat 31.49^N Long 34.30^W

and moderate trades steering S.E. by the wind middle
and latter part squally. Saw porpoises and other small
fey. Employed breaking out and flowing away in
the fore hatch. Lat 28.18^N Long 32.30^W

Thursday Nov 21st Comes in with fine weather
and moderate trades the Bark steering to the N.E.
middle and latter part much the same. Saw nothing
of importance. Employed getting the cutting gear.
