

1856 Bark Sea Shell Journal, 1856.  
Sunday Oct 26<sup>th</sup> Sea Account

First part of this day pleasant and light wind from N. at two took the Anchor, steering down the channel, with Capt. John Allen Pilot Middle part, at Ten came to Anchor at South Ferry Latter part, at half past six took the Anchor, steering down the channel at half past eight the Pilot left at nine abreast of point Judith light house one and a half miles distance steering S. wind W. at Twelve block Island bearing W. supposed Ten miles distance So Ends.

Lat 41.11 N.

Lon 71.11 W at Two

Monday Oct 27.

This day comes in with pleasant weather and light wind from W steering S with all sail set at four steering S by E. Middle part at seven took in fore top gallant sail and Fly V. Latter part, at day light set all sail So Ends this day.

Lat 39.15 N

Tuesday Oct 28. Lon. N. W. S.

This day comes in with cloudy weather and light wind from S W steering S. E. with all sail set, at four light rain. Middle part squally winds from Southward heady from N. E. to E with reef top sails and fore sail set. Latter part wind W.
