

Journal of a voyage kept on board the Ship *Charm* Capt. *John*

Sunday October 3. 1841

Fine weather with a light breeze from the Eastward steering on the wind to the Southward Under all sail Lat 34.10.23.41

Monday October 4. 1841

This day commences with a light breeze from E to W steering by the wind and E by N under all sail Sent up our Main and Mizzen Royal Masts and rigging out our Main Mast boom saw Humpbacks rattled down the Starboard Mizzen rigging Lat 31.05. Long 106.02. 1/2. 41

Tuesday October 5. 1841

Fresh gales from the W Westward to South steering E by N under all sail Rattled down the Foretopmast rigging Saw a whale sent up our Main Royal Mast Lat 28.54 Long 108.40. 1/2. 41

Wednesday October 6. 1841

Fine weather with a light breeze from the S E steering E N E under all sail. Rattling down Main topmast rigging and firing our Mizzen rigging Lat 27.56. Long 104.33. 1/2. 41

Thursday October 7. 1841

Fine weather with a light breeze from the Southward steering E N E under all sail. Sent up main royal mast and firing our Mizzen rigging Lat 27.47 Long 101.47

Friday October 8. 1841

This day commences with a fresh breeze from S E steering N E. All hands busy employed in setting up rigging and rattling down Lat 25.47 Long 107.30

Saturday October 9. 1841

This 24 hours strong breezes from the S E steering N E. Care away main royal halberd Lat 23.25 Long 116.00
