

Towards, Cape Horn in 1845

Sunday September the 24  
begins with strong Westly winds and overcast, steering E by N, under all sail, middle part strong breeze, took in the studding sails, latter part steering E, under double reef topsails, wind West and overcast, so ends, three men sick, ..

Latitude 55. 48. Longitude 86. 20. ..

Monday September the 25  
begins with strong gales from West, and hazy weather, steering East under double reef topsails, middle part light showers of rain, latter part set the maintop gallant sail over a single reef maintop sail with the wind West steering East, so ends, three men sick, Latitude 55 20. Longitude 82. 00

Tuesday September the 26  
commences with strong Westly winds, and light showers of rain, steering E, middle part the wind halled to the Southward, latter part the wind west made all sail set studding sails, so ends, three men sick.

Latitude 55. 10, Longitude 77. 09

Wednesday September the 27  
begins with light N.W. breezes steering E by N, attended with light showers of rain, middle part the wind halled to the S.W., steering E by N, latter part, set studding sails, course E by N, so ends, four men sick, Latitude 56. 39
