 and stood on our course the wind E by S. Middle parts like air and variable. Latter parts moderate
 breezes and pleasant at 11 A.M. made the land of St. Jago bearing S.E. distant a league

 Friday July 28th These 24 hours commences with moderate breezes from N.E. and cloudy Middle parts more
 moderate with squalls of rain Latter parts like breezes and variable. No Obs this day.
 Saturday July 29th These 24 hours commences with like air from east and pleasant, Middle parts calm Latter parts
 like breezes and variable so ends this day. No Obs this day.
 Sunday July 31st These 24 hours commences with like air and variable. Middle parts much the same Latter parts
 moderate breezes from north at 5 A.M. set the square sail ends pleasant Lat by Obs 13. 14 N.
 Monday August 1st These 24 hours commences with fine breezes from N.W. and pleasant, Middle parts the same all
 sail set Latter parts variable at 5 A.M. were ship at 11 A.M. saw a ship steering S.W. No Obs this day.
 Tuesday August 2nd These 24 hours commences with moderate breezes from N.W. and pleasant, Middle parts squalls
 of wind and rain. Latter parts much the same. No Obs this day.
 Wednesday August 3rd These 24 hours commences with fresh breezes from W.S.W. attended with rain at 4 P.M. dined on the
 main-sail, Middle parts cloudy. Latter parts moderate breezes and pleasant at 11 A.M. set the main
 sail and flying jib. saw a ship to leeward steering S.E. Lat by Obs 8. 11 S.
 Thursday August 4th These 24 hours commences with fresh breezes from S.W. and pleasant at 3 P.M. sight the ship *Christina*
 of Thigens 32 days out from Rotterdam bound to Barbours in the lat 8. 25 N. Long 17. 15 W
 Middle parts moderate squalls of wind and rain. Latter parts much the same.
 No Obs this Day.
 Friday August 5th 1842 These 24 hours commences with moderate breezes from S.W. and pleasant. Middle parts squally at
 12 P.M. took in the gaff top-sail. Latter parts steady breezes from south. Lat by Obs 5. 16 N.
 Saturday August 6th These 24 hours commences with moderate breezes and pleasant. Middle parts squally. Latter parts
 fine breezes from south, all sail set to the best advantage. Lat by Obs 4. 33 N.
 Sunday August 7th These 24 hours commences with moderate breezes from S.W. and pleasant. Middle and Latter
 parts much the same. ends cloudy. No Obs this day.
 Monday August 8th These 24 hours commences with fresh breezes from S by W. and cloudy at 4 P.M. riged in the jib-boom
 tacked ship and stood to the west. Middle and Latter parts much the same.
 Lat by Obs South N.
 Tuesday August 9th These 24 hours commences with moderate breezes from S. and pleasant. Middle parts fresh breezes
 and cloudy. Latter parts more moderate the wind S by E. Lat by Obs 2. 01 North.
 Wednesday August 10th These 24 hours commences with moderate breezes from S.E. and pleasant at 2 P.M. riged out the jib-boom
 employed in hauling out for provision opened a box of pork. Middle parts like Latter parts the same
 all sail set to the best advantage. Lat by Obs 1. 21 North.

 Latter parts calm so ends this day.
 Friday August 12th These 24 hours commences with like breezes from S.E. and pleasant weather, Middle parts much
 same Latter parts fine breezes and pleasant, all sail set to the best advantage Lat by Obs
 Saturday August 13th These 24 hours commences with moderate breezes from S.E. by S. and pleasant weather, Middle parts the
 same. Latter parts steady breezes, with pleasant weather. Lat by Obs 1. 21 South.
 Sunday August 14th These 24 hours commences with moderate breezes from south and pleasant weather, Middle parts the same
 Latter parts fresh breezes from S by E. all sail set to the best advantage. Lat by Obs 5. 53 S
 Long by Chron 18. 22 W
 Monday August 15th These 24 hours commences with moderate breezes from south and pleasant weather, Middle and Latter
 parts ends fresh breezes Lat by Obs 7. 26 S.
 Tuesday August 16th These 24 hours commences with fresh breezes from the S.E. and pleasant, Middle parts much the
 same with a head beat sea. Latter parts fresh breezes and pleasant. Lat by Obs 8. 22 S.
 Wednesday August 17th These 24 hours commences with fresh breezes from S.E. and pleasant weather with a heavy swell
 from south, Middle and Latter parts much the same at 5 A.M. pitched away the jib-boom
 ends pleasant. Lat by Obs 11. 40 S.
 Thursday August 18th These 24 hours commences with fresh breezes from S by E. and pleasant with a heavy swell.
 Middle parts fresh squalls of wind and rain. Latter parts moderate ends pleasant.
 Lat by Obs 13. 01 S.
 Friday August 19th These 24 hours commences fresh breezes from S by E. and pleasant with a ruff sea. Middle parts
 squally. Latter parts more moderate. ends pleasant. Lat by Obs 13. 51 S.
 Saturday August 20th These 24 hours commences with fresh breezes and squally weather the wind S by E at 3 P.M.
 reefed the main-sail, Middle parts the same. Latter parts more moderate at 6 A.M. set
 the main-sail ends pleasant the wind S.E. Lat by Obs 17. 47 S.
 Sunday August 21st These 24 hours commences with moderate breezes from S.E. and squally weather, Middle parts the same
 Latter parts fresh breezes with squalls of wind and rain, ends pleasant. Lat by Obs 18. 30
 Monday August 22nd These 24 hours commences with moderate breezes from S.E. and squally weather, Middle
 parts more moderate and clear. Latter parts fresh breezes and pleasant. Lat by Obs 21. 21
 Tuesday August 23rd These 24 hours commences with moderate breezes from S.E. and pleasant employed in faking
 the jib-boom at 5 P.M. riged it out. Middle parts like air from south and clear. Latter parts
 like breezes ends the same. all sail set to the best advantage Lat by Obs 22. 22.
 Wednesday August 24th These 24 hours commences with moderate breezes from south and pleasant, Middle parts fresh breezes
 at mid night riged in the jib-boom. Latter parts the same. Lat by Obs 23. 17 S.
