

Ship *Thine* *Robinson* in *hull* *to* *page* *to* *New* *London* *Journal* *Shore* *and* *Sea*  
 These 24 hours commences with fresh breezes from N.W. and pleasant weather, at 4 P.M. the  
 windward, steering S.E. but could not make out what she was. Middle parts squally  
 at midnight light air and variable, but on the square sail. Latter parts pleasant weather  
 at 4 A.M. the wind hauled to E.S.E. lashed ship, course north, at 11 A.M. foremast  
 square sail, ends with fine breezes from E. by S.  
 Lat by Obs 33° 55'  
 Long by Chron 72° 15' W

Monday  
 These 24 hours commences with fresh breezes from E.S.E. and pleasant weather, course S. by W. at 2 P.M. strike the  
 southern edge of the gulf, and huff of N.W.W. Middle parts squally, a heavy sea running, at 3 P.M.  
 the wind hauled to S.E. and light air, hauled on the wind, Latter parts moderate breeze and  
 variable, at 6 A.M. saw a Bark ship to leeward steering S.S.E. at 8 saw a frigate off whence steering  
 N.W. at 9 A.M. riged out the jib-boom and set the jib, ends fresh breezes from E. by S. and hazy  
 weather, all sail set to the best advantage, course north.  
 Lat by Obs 31. 1. 1  
 Long by Chron 72. 54 W.

Monday  
 These 24 hours commences with moderate breezes from variable, Middle parts light air from  
 E. S. E. and evening, a smooth sea, at 4 A.M. the wind hauled to S.W. jibed ship, Latter  
 parts light air and foggy weather, at 11 A.M. spoke a Dutch Brig bound to New York  
 and another steering S. E., ends clear.  
 Lat by Obs 30. 1. 1  
 Long by Chron 72. 51 W.

Tuesday  
 These 24 hours commences with light breezes from S. S. W. and pleasant weather, at 4 P.M. saw a  
 ship a head steering S.E. at 5 shut in a thick fog, got the anchor to the bow, at 6 P.M. sounded  
 in 15 fathoms blood & white sand, steering S.S.E. at half past 6 saw the land, the south side  
 of Long Island, bearing S. S. E. by compass distant 2 miles, jibed ship and hauled up  
 E. S. E. on the light, Middle parts light air, at 8 A.M. mounted light sea west, Latter  
 parts light air and calm, and thick foggy weather, between Montek point and Lewis Island.
