Monday July 21

Begins with strong breezes and rainy weather double reef the topsails took in jib and mizen last part light gale from West steering S.E. picked up a large sperm saw porpoises Ends

Begins with light gale from West steering South last part weather the same. Saw porpoises

Wednesday July 23

Came with clear gales from N.W. steering South last part wind West Ends

Begins with calm weather one sail in sight last part light air from West saw grampasses

Begins with light air from N.W. heading N.N.E. saw a schooner heading to the westward last part weather the same

Tuesday July 29

Came with light air from N.W. heading N.N.E. men employed in duties of the ship last part light air from N.E. saw blackfish toward did not get fast
