Wednesday July 30

Came with light breeze from N. E. steering N. W. at night squally attended with rain laid a ship to windward steering the same way last part fine weather saw St Michaels bearing S. W. dist 30 miles  
Lat 35-33 Long 25-50

Thursday July 31

Begins with light breeze from N. E. and pleasant weather steering S. W. saw grasshopper and porpoises  
Lat 34-05 Long 27-18

Friday August 1

Came with light breeze from East steering S. W. Island twice bearing N. W. dist 15 miles last part calm breeze bearing S. W. dist 10 miles saw plenty of blackfish toward did not get fast

Saturday August 2

Came with light breeze from S. W. heading N. W. saw blackfish toward but got none three sails in sight middle and last part fresh breeze and squally weather downbleve reef the topsails. At 12 wind bore S. W. cleared off saw two sails bore to the Eastward

Sunday Aug 3

Begins with moderate breeze from N. W. steering for Fayal bearing S. S. W. dist 30 miles last part fresh breeze from East laying off and on on the North side of Fayal  
Thus Ends

Monday August 4

Begins with fresh breeze from East laying off on on at Fayal get any thing done lay off steering South thus Ends

Tuesday Aug 5th

light breeze and pleasant weather steering South at night Fayal bearing S. S. W. dist 10 miles 7 sails in sight toward for grasshopper did not get fast  
Thus Ends  
Lat 37-50 Long 25-05

Wednesday Aug 6th

Came with light breeze from S. W. pleasant weather heading S. E. at 6 AM saw a black to windward whaling whale working to leeward the steerman went on to one his helms mist him boats came by the ship after them  
Thus Ends  
Lat 36-44 Long 27-00

Thursday Aug 7

Begins with rough weather wind S. W. tip the ship off S. S. E. after the whale chased them all night but got nothing at night double reef the topsails lay off South in the direction the whale was going threw the night fresh breeze with rain. At 6 cleared off mast all still stood to the Southward saw Island St Michaels bearing East dist 15 miles  
Lat 37-40 Long 25-40

Friday August 8

Begins with pleasant breeze from West steering S. S. W. by compass last part weather the shore men employed in duties of the ship  
Thus Ends  
Lat 36-25 Long 25-40
