Commencement of these 24 Hours Strong breeze from the WSW Headed to the South at 4 O'clock nominal Land Bore by Compass N E & Distance 8 Miles from which I take my departure in 41° 14' N and Long 70° 50' W Took in the fore Topgall Sail and Reef from top sail and Main sail Middle Part Strong breeze and Pleasant Double Reef the Top sail

Latter Part Moderate Sot all sail at 5 Jack Ship Standing N W at 7 Jack Ship to the South wind W S W to S W point variation to the westward So Ends this 24 hours Lat by Ob 40 05 Long by Chro the 21 70 50 Long by S R 70 50

Tuesday May ^{the} 21 1839

This day begins with Pleasant weather Over head and brisk breeze from the WSW Headed to the South at 4 O'clock Jack Ship to the N W Took in the Topgallant Sail and Reef the Fore Top sail Middle Part Squally at 10 Jack Ship Squall from the N E Took in sail from 10 to 4 Lite and Bearable

Latter Part brisk breeze from the East Made all sail Saw nothing End Smokey

Variation of Point Westerly Lat by Ob 39 16 Long by Chro 71 22 Long by S R 71 20 Lat by S R 39 15

Wednesday May ^{the} 22 1839
Begins with Lite breeze from the S E But smokey Headed to the SW at 4 O'clock Calm at 4 O'clock Calm breeze at Grampus blow

Middle Part Lite breeze from the S E to WSW at 7 O'clock Jack Ship to the S Wind kind from WSW to SW and very flattering Saw black fish and Grampuses and one Brigg in Shore at 8 O'clock got an altitude Long 72 12 Ends Calm Lat by Ob 39 10 By S R 39 7 Long by S R 72 10

Thursday May ^{the} 23 1839

This day begins with Calms and thick fog at 4 O'clock Lite breeze from the N E Middle Part brisk breeze from the N E heading S W Latter Part same as the middle and Rainy Steering S W Saw a Brigg on the weather beam Steering the same to ends this day Lat by Ob 37 53 Long by S R 73 35

Friday May ^{the} 24 1839

This day begins stiff breeze from the E and thick fog Shorten sail theading to the S and S E and E Middle Part Lite air from the S E Latter Part kind SW Jack Ship to the S Eastward heading from E to S E and Lite at 8 O'clock up at 10 spoke 10th Attalanta of and from went tocket 11 O'clock no O'clock boiling out black fish Ends Pleasant
