

Saturday May 25 1840

Commencement of this day, Lite known from the N Headed Ship to Water 60° at 8 O'clock 64 Headed to below till 12 from 12 to 44 Water 60 to 58 Headed SW till 7 Water 70 Past a Riff running to SW ESE with Great Quantity of Gulf Weed etc & Got a Linner which made the Log 73.22 thro 73.42 Headed to Water 64 Sounded with 100 Paw Several Sail the Water 70 Blue 64 Green 50 Lines this day Sailing Down Lat by Alt 56.56 Long by Alt 70 42 Linner 73.22

Sunday May 26 1840

Commencement of this day, Lite known from the SE Headed at 8 Saw Spinn Whales Under the Bow called Land but could not run up with them Exploded in Towing, Water 58 Green Saw Several Sails

Part Headed WSW Lat by Alt 56.56 Long by Alt 70 42

Moderate and Cloudy Headed SE Wind Lite from the SE at 12 Water 60 Green Saw 1 whale 5 Miles on our Star Headed with his Landboard Tacks on Board Lat by Alt 57.10 Long by Linner 73.03

Monday May 25 1840

Commencement of this day Wind S Headed at 8 Water 62 Middle Part Wind the same Water 62 Late Part Wind SE Headed at 8 Saw a Ship on our Star Headed at 8 Got a Linner abt 12 miles off which made the Log 73.42 thro 73.21 Got another fast ditto which made the Log 73.20 thro 73.22 the third a little to star which made the Log 73.21 thro 73.23 So ends this day with Black known from the SE Headed at Lat by Alt 58 17 Long by Alt 73 22 Long by Linner 73 20

Sunday May 26 1840

Commencement of this day, Black known from the SE Headed at 8 Water 58 at 6 O'clock Tack to the SE at 7 Land for Black fish but could not catch them

Middle Part came at the first at 2 Tack Wind S Headed at 8 to the SE Water 58 Late Part at 8 Tack to the W Wind ESE Water 56 Got 60 Sals of Distances the first made the Log 73.43 thro 73.32 the Second Linner 70.26 thro 70 36 Mean of the Linner 73 34 1/2 of thro 73.34 Lat by Alt 58.46 Water 64 by Linner 73.37 Long by Alt 73.39

Wednesday May 27 1840

Commencement of this day, Lite known from the SE Headed at 8 Water 54

Middle Part same with the Wind Boffin Water 56 Green Late Part below at 10 Land for Black fish each boat got 1 Starboard boat got 2 Water 56 Lat by Alt 58 56 Long by Alt 73.55 by DR 73.45

Thursday May 28 1840

Commencement of this day below at 1 Saw Black fish Land Landboard boat got one Starboard boat got one but lost it at Land for Black fish Starboard boat got one Landboard boat got above faster to 3 lost them Water 56

Middle Part being Black fish, below all night Late Part Exploded Stowing down and the 6 made 3 barrels Saw Black fish going by but to down ward it to the SE did not lose known from the SE Headed Lat by Alt 59 00 Long by Alt 73.45 Long by Linner 73.28
