headed w water to bounded with no few
several sail the water to blue 64 green to brown
this day bearing down
Lumen 73.22

Sunday May 3d 1840
was an account of his day he knew from
the S.S. Headland who at I saw sperm whales
when the bow galled land. But could not
run up with them employed in tarry water &
then saw several seals

Middle Part Barking Black fish. Salmon
All nighte 9
Late Part - Englorde Slowing down and
At the 6 made 3 barrels Saw black fish going eye
out to windward i.e. to the SSW did now turn
to leeward from the SSW Headwind
S Long by DR 28.45
