

Wednesday May 15 1874

These 24 hours commenced with light winds and rain at 6 AM sprang to sail, bound to New York Middle part strong breeze from N steering N at 3 it hauled back the head yards, wind laid so until 2 then steering N so ends these 24 hours

Thursday 16

These 24 hours commenced with a light breeze to the N and E several sail in sight and several sunfish at 2 AM hauled the masts and took in sail at 5 AM spoke the *Diagona of Whippoorwill* Capt. Sam. on 24 months out 60 or 70 miles at 9 AM black fish board and took 2 at 10 PM Haul on deck so ends these 24 hours

Friday 17

These 24 hours commenced with a light breeze from the N and E at 12 PM saw black fish board and took 1 saw several other schools but did not board at 6 AM commenced to work on the fish at 7 spoke the *Diagona* bound home so ends these 24 hours

Saturday 18

These 24 hours commenced with a light breeze all hands in boiling water at 9 AM head down turned up 2 AM one sail in sight so ends these 24 hours

Sunday 19

These 24 hours commenced with a light breeze from the N steering on the ground and to N at 8 AM saw black fish board and took 2 out them in 10 ends these 24 hours

Monday May 20 1874

First part calm at 1 PM saw black fish board but without success in the afternoon 6 AM hauled back and took 3 took them on deck took in sail and got the masts at 8 commenced boiling so ends these 24 hours

Tuesday 21

First part fine weather all hands in boiling water at 1 PM took 2 and 3 AM hauled back and took 1 at 10 PM Haul on deck so ends these 24 hours

Wednesday 22

These 24 hours commenced with a light breeze from the N and E at 12 PM saw black fish board and took 1 saw several other schools but did not board at 6 AM commenced to work on the fish at 7 spoke the *Diagona* bound home so ends these 24 hours

Thursday 23

First part steady breeze from the N and E at 12 PM saw black fish board and took 1 saw several other schools but did not board at 6 AM commenced to work on the fish at 7 spoke the *Diagona* bound home so ends these 24 hours

Friday 24

These 24 hours commenced with a light breeze from the N steering on the wind nothing in sight of any consequence all hands employed in ships duties and last part light breeze fine weather so ends these 24 hours

Saturday 25

These 24 hours commenced with a light breeze from the N steering by the wind steered down 10 AM of black fish oil, 1 sail in sight in the middle and last part fine weather but no fish in sight of any consequence so ends these 24 hours
