Mon Aug 11th

Strong wind from NW to
W by N to NW by N and N by W
Lat 58.59 very squally under short sail
Long 68.05 in the edge of the Gulf Stream
Middle and East part squally
threw the log marks at one hour
Do End

Tues Aug 12th

Strong wind and very squally
under double reefs Employed
Lat 58.51 in cleaning try pots and calves
gear Middle and East part by
to the NW still in the Gulf
very squally with thunder and
lightning and rain Do End

Wed Aug 13th

Strong wind and very squally
with rain by to the NW by W
Lat 59.19 under short sail Employed in
cleaning craft still in the Gulf
Middle squally with rain
gave the log marks and took in sail as required
East part by to the NW raining

Thurs Aug 14th

Brisk wind and squally weather
by to the NW by N wind from the NW
Lat 40.28 Employed in Sunday day at 8
Long 68.58 in it cleared up some sun
steering to the East Middle thick
and heavy the wind veered to the NW
NW and W by N East part saw several
heads leading to the E. Exposed
one the End at 11 by N

Frid Aug 15th

Brisk wind from the NW steering
NW by N at 12 PM steered N by W all
Bail out any number of sails in
sight going different ways at 1 PM
steered S by E at 8 saw Gay Head light
and the light boat off cutting in
holding N by E Middle strong wind
and squally double reefed the top sail
making about looking for a pilot
to know purposes at 5 AM kept off
to run up the Bay at 6 found a
pilot
