 Begins with fresh gale from SW steering ESE
 at 8 P.M. squally the wind at last backing SSE
 the Middle fresh gale from SE heading South the
 top of sails at 8 P.M. tacked heading SE at 10 P.M.
 picked up a Calm of rain So ends this

 Lat 39-34 N
 Long 50-50 W
 Begins with light wind from SW steering
 East and sail steering East the Middle and latter
 part fresh gale at South heading ESE So ends

Wednesday August 4th
 Lat 39-44 N
 Long 48-44 W
 Begins with fresh gale from SW steering ESE under
 all sail top sails and courses at 8 P.M. squally with
 rain to the top of sails the Middle and latter
 part fine weather wind SE made all sail So ends

Thursday August 5th

 Begins with light wind from SW the Ship under
 all sail steering ESE the Middle foggy
 the latter part fine weather wind SE So ends

Friday August 6th

 ESE the Ship under all sail steering
 ESE the Middle and latter
 part fine weather So ends

 part clear weather So ends this day

 Begins with light wind from South steering ESE from
 the Middle and latter part fresh gale steering
 the same sail standing to the Eastward

Monday August 9th
 Lat 39-25 N
 Long 35-50 W
 Begins with fresh gale from SW steering ESE
 fine weather at 8 P.M. the Ship under all sail and
 I then I could not strike the Middle and latter part fine

Tuesday August 10th
 Lat 39-16 N
 Long 34-00 W
 Begins with fine and I place out gale at SW steering
 ESE with all sail set the Middle and latter part
 fine weather and sail in light So ends this

Wednesday August 11th
 Lat 39-31 N
 Long 32-34 W
 Begins with light wind from at SW the Ship under
 all sail sail steering ESE the Middle and latter part
 light wind from the Eastward heading SE So ends

Thursday August 12th

 Begins with light wind from SE the Ship under
 all sail that would draw standing to the Eastward
 the Middle the same the latter steering SE wind SW So ends

Friday August 13th

 Begins with light wind from SW the Ship under all sail that
 would draw steering ESE at 1 P.M. made the Island of
 closer bearing SE dist 22 miles by compass the Middle and
 latter part fresh gale and squally the wind SW So ends

Saturday August 14th
 Lat 39-33 N
 Long 28-24 W
 Begins with fresh gale from SW steering ESE and squally the Middle and
 latter part the storm got off 100 bushels of potatoes and
 15 bushels of onions to each loading off and on

Sunday August 15th
 Lat 39-00 N
 Long 25-08 W
 Begins with fresh wind from SW steering ESE at 8 P.M. the light
 came on board made all sail and I stand SE at 10 P.M. made
 the Island of Pagan bearing SE dist 10 miles then ESE So ends
