February Monday the 9th 1857

Commences with strong breezes from the S. S. W. with fog & rain, laying at anchor in New port harbour Rufus Colburn & John Holmes & William Smith got on shore in a shore boat

June 26th Sea-account last part 1852

Took on board the pilot and made sail
the winds light and varyable steering south

June 27th
the pilot still on board the first part went

from the S. S. W. at 8 o'clock A. M. dropped
anchor in the veryard sound at 4 P. M. took the
anchor and went to holmes hole at 8 o'clock took
the anchor went out steering to the Eastward
