 3 pm steved 12 b. V. Middle port weather  
 continues about the same. About 8 pm a steamer  
 passed steering westward. Gotter part light south  
 west of side. By 11 and 12 1/2. About 9 am  
 two steamers passed steering westward.

Oct 29<sup>th</sup> 1877  
 Long 67. 12 1/2

Thursday Oct 29<sup>th</sup>  
 morning with light southerly breeze  
 and pleasant weather. By 11 pm 12 1/2  
 1/2 m wind veered further northwesterly. By 1  
 1/2 m 12 1/2. Middle port wind continues about the  
 same. At daylight a steamer in sight steering westward  
 latter part wind continues about the same until about  
 9 am when wind veered easterly. Looked to 12 1/2  
 vessel off the bar in section. Oct. 30 32 1/2  
 Long 68. 19 1/2

Friday Oct 30<sup>th</sup>  
 morning with light breeze at 10 1/2 m 12 1/2. About  
 1 3/4 m breeze of standard port wind veered. By 2  
 1/2 m 12 1/2. Middle port wind veered from  
 Boston bound to Panama. Looked to 12 1/2  
 loaded with potatoes here and powder. About 3 1/2 m  
 wind veered easterly. Looked to 12 1/2  
 two sailing vessels and a steamer in sight on eastern  
 look. Middle port wind veered and veered  
 westward. At 4 1/2 m 12 1/2. Looked to 12 1/2  
 About 8 1/2 m strong breeze by 11 1/2 m 12 1/2. Looked to  
 for light easterly and light. Latter part  
 light breeze back and forth. Several  
 times found about 1/2 m. Oct. 31 53 1/2  
 Long 70. 44 1/2

Saturday Oct 31<sup>st</sup> 1877  
 morning with light breeze and clear  
 weather. By 11 1/2 m 12 1/2. Middle port  
 weather still of Boston bound to Panama. Looked to  
 12 1/2. Middle port wind veered and the breeze  
 the light breeze. At 11 1/2 m 12 1/2. Middle port  
 Looked to light breeze. Wind from 12 1/2. Middle port  
 12 1/2. Middle port light breeze. Middle port light breeze about  
 12 1/2. Middle port light breeze.
