Thursday 24. First part of this day commences with a light breeze from north steering S. by E. midle & last part the same at dark took in the light sails & double reef the four topsail at daylight made all sail to gain all hands employed in fitting the boats latitude of 44.00. N Long 68.40

Friday 25. First part of this day begins with a light breeze from the north midle & last part the same all sail on the ship steering S. by E. the watch employed in fitting the boats fine pleasant weather no blackfish going quick plenty of sails in sight  
Lat 55.54. N Long 67.15.

Saturday 26. First part of this day begins with a light breeze from the S. by W steering to Westward S. by E midle & last part calm the men employed in fitting the rigging & boats fine pleasant weather nothing in sight  
Lat 46 Long

Sunday 27. First part of this day begins with a light breeze from the S. by W midle & last part the same ship steering S. by E fine pleasant weather the men employed in ship duty  
Lat 57.19. Long

Monday 28. First part of this day begins with a light breeze from the S. by W steering E. all sail on the ship midle part a squally hail part fine no sun thing look like storm whales but the watch going quick to the air and the men employed in ship duty & ends this day
