6 **TUE FRI** AUG the 7th Fore and middle part of this day light winds and pleasant latter part strong wind one sail in sight watch employed in ship duty
 course E Wind WSW

7 **SAT** AUG the 8th Fore and middle part squally and rainy latter part strong wind and pleasant all hands employe in washing and mending nothing in sight
 course E Wind WSW

8 **SUN** AUG the 9th These 24 hours squally with plenty of rain and thunder and lightning very unpleasant nothing in sight

9 **MON** AUG the 10th These 24 hours strong breeze and squally with heavy rain nothing in sight at 11 AM took in two reefs in each topsail watch employed in ship duty very unpleasant

10 **TUES** AUG the 11th These 24 hours strong breeze and pleasant this day took out for water watch employed in ship duty nothing in sight

11 **WDS** AUG the 12th These 24 hours strong breeze and pleasant the watch employed in ship duty nothing in sight but I hope there will be some

12 **THUR** AUG the 13th These 24 hours light wind and pleasant at 6 AM saw a school of blackfish but did not lower the watch employed in ship duty nothing in sight

13 **FRI** AUG the 14th These 24 hours light winds and variable and very pleasant saw a bruch proved to be a gump watch employed in ship duty one sail in sight the part of this day course EBN
 latter part strong full and by

14 **SAT** AUG 15th These 24 hours light wind and pleasant at 5 AM raised sperm whales at 7 AM lowered they boats and give chase but did not get fast at 1 PM came on board saw black whale they watch employed in ship duty one sail in sight at sunset Shortline sail and stered by the wind
 Wind NWBW
 LAT BY OBS 36-20 Lon 43-43

15 **SUN** AUG 16th These 24 hours light wind and pleasant at sunrise raised sperm whales going quick to the north at 7 AM lowered they boat and gave chase but did not get fast at 11 AM came on board this day saw the east of a sperm whale to sail in sight at sunset Shortline sail and stered by the wind
