All this Day light breezes from  
the S.E. and pleasant weather  
steering N.W. by W

All this Day light breezes from  
the S.E. steering N.W. by W  
vary pleasant weather

Lat by Obs 12. 44 North  
Long by Chronometer 49. 00 West

Thursday 25th of March 1841

All this Day fresh breezes from  
the E. and cloudy kind of weather  
steering N.W. by W

Lat by Obs 14. 48 North

Friday 26th of March 1841  
Throughout this Day light  
breezes from the S.E. & steering  
N.W. vary pleasant weather

Lat by Obs 16. 30 North  
Long by Chronometer 53. 30 West

Saturday 27th of March  
Throughout this Day light breezes  
from the S.E. steering N.W. by W  
pleasant weather saw one Finback  
and 3 Sails two steering to the W  
and one to the S.W.

Lat by Obs 18. 31 North  
Long by Chron. 55. 35 West

Sunday 28th of March 1841  
All this Day light breezes  
from the S.E. and pleasant  
weather steering N.W. one still  
in sight spoke her Roanoke

Lat by Obs 20. 00 North  
Long by Chron. 57. 00 West

Monday 29th of March  
First part of this Day light  
breezes from the S.E. some light  
and distant thunder steering N.W.  
in company with the Roanoke  
latter part wind more to the  
South
