Weather Roanoke in sight off
your Starboard beam

Saturday 3rd of April 1841
First part of this Day Light breeze
from the SE and clear weather
steering N by W Latter part wind
from the N by W and squally at
4 o'clock took a squall split the
jib which it mended it bent it
again & steering on the wind N by E
Lat by Obs 26, 30 Long 64 07

Sunday 4th of April 1841
First part of this Day Light
breeze from the SE steering N by W
the wind N by W pleasant
Weather Latter part Light breeze
from the SE and SE, very
pleasant, two sails in sight
Ahead

Lat by Obs 27, 17 N
Long by the 64, 45 W

Monday 5th of April
First part of this Day Light
breeze from the SE and pleasant
Weather steering N by W
Latter part Light breeze from
the SE and W, saw 5 sails
3 steering to the N and W
one NE and one bound to the
South

Lat by Obs 29, 00
Long by the 65, 00

Tuesday 6th of April 1841
First part of this Day Light
breeze from the N by W and pleasant
Weather steering N by W
Middle part squally and the wind
to the N and E Latter part West
again and clear weather 1 sail in
sight steering to the N and W

Lat by Obs 30, 40 M
Long by the 67, 07 W

Wednesday 7th of April 1841
2nd Day commences with Light
breeze from the SE steering N by W
clear weather 2 sails in sight
steering the same way Latter part
cloudy weather
