Saturday June 9th 1855
 Light breeze from N. and
 S.W. and fine weather. Saw 2 sails. Heaving from
 S.W. by S. E. Lat. 37. 57 N.
 Lon. 63. 54 W.

Sunday June 10th
 Light air and calm the first
 part. At 11 A.M. took a breeze from S. At 4 P.M.
 hauled top gallant sails. Saw 3 sails. Heaving
 by the wind S. E. Lat. 33. 20 N.
 Lon. 62. 14 W.

Monday June 11th
 Strong breeze from S. E. and
 S. W. and cloudy. Heaving S. E. Lat. 39. 00 N.
 Lon. 59. 48 W.

Tuesday June 12th
 Fresh breeze from S. W. and
 cloudy. Under close reef. Heaving S. E. Lat. 38. 15 N.
 Lon. 58. 00 W.

Wednesday June 13th
 Moderate breeze from S. and
 hazy. Saw finbacks. Course E. by S. Lat. 32. 32 N.
 Lon. 55. 05 W.

Thursday June 14th
 Fresh breeze from S. and S. E.
 and fair weather. Under single reef the latter part
 Saw a sail so leeward. Heaving E. by S. E. Lat. 39. 10 N.
 Lon. 51. 49 W.

Friday June 15th
 Fresh breeze from S. and fair
 weather. Saw three sails. Heaving by the wind S.
 E. Under single reef. Lat. 39. 20 N.
 Lon. 49. 23 W.

Ocean on board bark Tropic Bird of N. Bedford

Saturday June 16th
 Strong breeze from S. W. and hazy
 At 5 A.M. saw sperm whale close aboard the ship. Lowered
 one boat without success. Saw several sail steering
 S. E. By the wind on opposite decks. Lat. 33. 54 N.
 Lon. 47. 40 W.

Sunday June 17th
 First part strong breeze and cloudy
 latter part moderate and fair. Lat. 38. 30 N.
 Lon. 47. 13 W.

Monday June 18th
 First part moderate breeze from
 S. W. and fair, latter part strong breeze and cloudy.
 Exchanged signals with an English brig steering
 E. by S. Heaving by the wind N. W. Lat. 32. 42 N.
 Lon. 43. 27 W.

Tuesday June 19th
 First part fresh breeze from
 N. W. latter part moderate breeze from E. and hazy
 with some rain.

Wednesday June 20th
 No observation
 First part fresh breeze from N. E.
 and rain, latter part light breeze from N. E. and
 hazy. Saw blackfish. Lat. 38. 20 N.
 Lon. 47. 27 W.

Thursday June 21st
 Moderate breeze varying from
 N. E. to N. W. first part clear latter part cloudy. Saw
 1 sail. Course S. E. Lat. 33. 50 N.
 Lon. 45. 50 W.
