Nothing of life to be seen

Friday June 6th N^o 15
Commenced with light wind from WNW. Fine
weather. Course in various parts of ship's
& masts of the fore, middle & latter part. Light
wind from West at 4 PM
Lat. 29. 56 N
Long 50. 16 W

Saturday June 7th N^o 16
First part light wind from West. Steered at
1 PM East. saw a few birds & much gull waste at
7 PM. Shortened sail & headed to the SSW. Latter
part light wind & cloudy some rain at 8 PM
set top gallant sails & steered N E. see grampias
Lat. 30. 21 N
Long 49. 44 W

Sunday June 8th N^o 17
Begins with a breeze from N E. & clear weather
at 4 PM the wind N E. at 7 PM shortened sail
headed to the East. Latter part light wind
from S by W at 8 PM set all sail & steered N E. at
9 PM saw a shoal of sperm whales going quick
to the North. Sounded 2 boats in chase
Lat. 30. 59 N
Long 48. 41. 30 W

Monday June 9th N^o 18
Begins with fine weather. at 3 PM took up the
boats could not get on. at 4 PM lowered again
with no success at 5 PM took up the boats
& steered North at 5 PM steered WNW at 10 PM
by the wind to the N E
Lat. 32. 07 N
Long 49. 00 W

steering by the wind to the S by E. Mid part
tacked to the N W. Latter part moderate breeze
& cloudy at 7 PM tacked to the South. Course in

Wednesday June 11th N^o 20
Commenced with moderate breeze from West
& cloudy at 7 PM the wind N W by W head up
S W by W brought a prospect. Mid & latter part
the wind N W & steered West. see killers
Lat. 30. 30 N
Long 49. 49 W

Thursday June 12th N^o 21
Begins with moderate breeze from N E. at
1 PM tacked to the East. Middle & latter part
light wind from N W. at 2 PM tacked to the
N W
Lat. 30. 41 N
Long 49. 22 W

Friday June 13th N^o 22
First part begins with light wind from
N W. steering by the wind to the N W. see a
large flock of sperm Mid & latter part
light air from N E. at 4 PM a passing squall
of rain
Lat. 31. 11 N
Long 49. 51 W

Saturday June 14th N^o 23
Begins with light wind from N E. to N W. at
4 PM the wind to the N E. at 7 PM saw black fish
lowered for them with no success took up
the boats Mid part light air. Latter part
breeze. unbenit the Miz top sail altered
it & bent it again
