Both these logs give a daily account of the whales seen, ships "spoke," direction of the winds, weather conditions, etc.

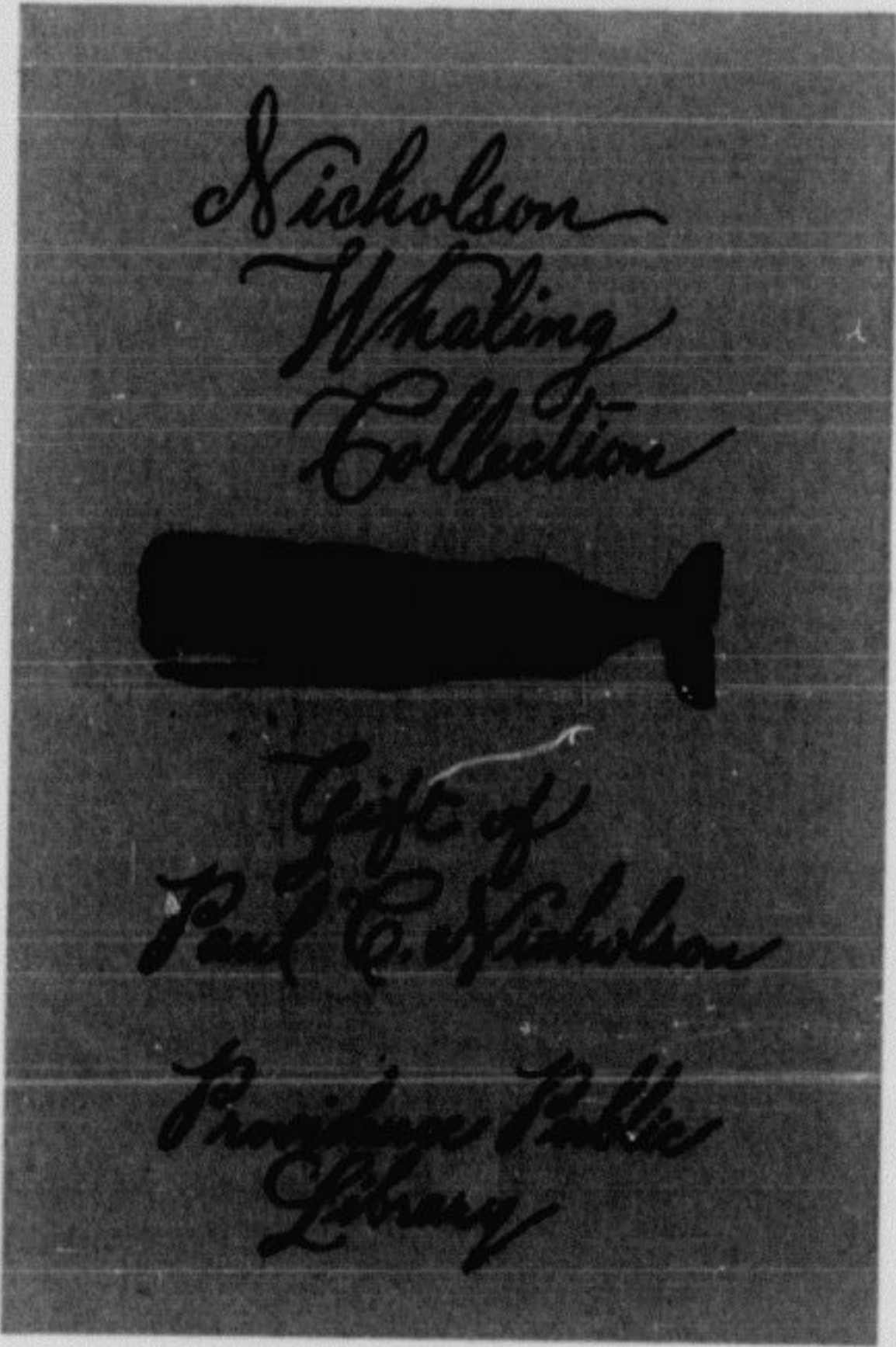
Probably ship "Good Return" of New Bedford

Sailed Sept. 4 1830 - ended Mar 10 1833

Mate lost 1831 - Detained at Talcahuano 5 months
on a jinxed voyage - Chilean got paid \$20,000 in 1835
as an "insurrection"

"Good Return" 376 tons - Job Terry Jr. capt. - Job Eddy managing
owner's agent - 450 sperm oil
2,500 whale
20,000 lb bone
