HINDER'S NOTE

Author: Logbook
 Title: Bark VALPARAISO/Bark ATLANTIC
 Place and date: 1845 - 1858

Condition when received: Logbook damaged by water and mildew. Leather covers rotted. Marble sides badly worn. Boards loose, spine shaken. Pages rotted by mildew and badly stained.

Work performed: Disassembled, sterilized book, resized pages with nylon, reduced stains, mended and reinforced paper with Japanese tissue as necessary and resewed on three hemp cords. Rebound in new boards, best calfskin and original marble sides over Japanese paper sides. Replaced original end sheets and "Tabor" broadside flyleaf.
