Strong Winds At 6 A M got  
under way to go to sea & working  
out of the harbor so ends this  
day by low A count

September the 17

Begins With light Winds from  
N A steering out of the bound  
Fairly in steering the anchors  
At 6 A M set the "Watches".  
Mid Part light Winds and Variable  
steering S E under all sail. Latter  
Part At 6 A M a strong Wind from  
N N E took in the topgallant.  
Sails Fairly in setting up the main  
sloop in 10 Furlled with 12 took  
in gill net mancala so ends With  
A gale
