 Sailed from New Bedford Aug 16-1917

Thurs 16-

Pulled out of Deep Hole and anchored ship off Clarks point to wait favorable weather for starting. Two men failed to turn up - Costantino Jones and Charles Almeida

Fri 17-

Got under way at about 9 a.m. and towed to a shelter under the lee of Penikese, the wind being S.E. and stormy. Lots of rain and thunder and lightning.

Sat 18

Day started with fresh N.W. winds and ended with light S.W. winds. Vessel was got under way and sailed out of the sound. Passed No Mans land at 3 P.M. course steered S. S. E.

Sun 19

First part of day calm, and later sprang up a little air from S.W. This morning we saw about 15 or maybe a little more men-of-war steaming to the westward. Caught a few cod and Hake. course steered S. E.
