

Saturday Dec 17th commences with light winds from ENE
comes at 1 P.M. put on the fore top saul Middle and
Lat 55, 12 latter part the same all hands employd in shift
SSE duty so ends these 24 hours

Sunday Dec 18th these 24 hours commences with fresh breezes
comes from the S, at 2 P.M. sent the S.S. yard and sail
E by S soft and set it latter part at 5 P.M. the
Lat 54, 15 wind hauled to the westward, squared the yards and
steared E by S, so ends these 24 hours, with frequent squalls

Monday Dec 19th commences with strong breezes from the westward
Lat 53, 15 hauled in the Fore top S. sailer at half past 5 A.M. middle
part squally with rain reefed the topsails at 12 P.M.
and furled the mainsail, set the same at 6 P.M.
all hands employd in ships duty so ends this day

Tuesday Dec 20th this day commences with light winds
and fair weather the wind from the Eastward
wind by the wind put the soft topsail and spanker at 9 P.M. so ends
these twenty four hours backed ship at 10 P.M.
steading to the eastward and haling to the Southward

Wednesday Dec 21st commences with light breezes with squalls
comes from the southward all sail set with fine
W by S breeze and going her course and is E by N
middle moderate with stiddy breezes from the
westward latter the same all hands employd in ships
duty so ends this day

Thursday Dec 22nd commences with light breezes from the
W by S Westward on tent the fore topsail, and bent a nother
middle part moderate with light breeze
latter part commenced standing aloft to
lookout for whale so ends this day

Friday Dec 23rd commences with light winds from
the E by S the W ward fore part fitted studsail gear
N by W mid part light winds and fair weather latter
part sent out foretopmast studsail, wind
chanting to the W by S, based round and set
the studsail gear

Saturday
comes from the W commences with fine breezes, Middle the
W by S C by S came later part bent a fore topmast studsail
split a old iron and bent anew so ends this day

Sunday Dec 24th commences with favorable breezes from
the W middle part light breezes latter the same
Lat 52, 58 C by S all sail set the wind aft, so ends this day

Monday Dec 25th commences with light winds from
the Westward set up the gib byes fitted the
C by S lower studsail rigging latter part light
breezes going S by N, so ends this day

Tuesday Dec 26th commences with favor breezes from
SSE the Westward, Middle very moderate saw
Westerly a ship standing to the SSE, raised a whale
and proved to be a finback latter part fine
rigged out down studsail beams so ends this day

Wednesday Dec 27th commences with light breezes fore part
set a lower studsail, latter part wind
close by the wind a head took in the studsail
so ends these 24 hours

Thursday Dec 28th commences with light winds
from the south and W all sail set
and steering by the wind all hands
employd in ships duty to ends this day

Friday Dec 29th commences with light winds and
pleasant weather sent out the S.S. loon latter part
under the S.S. and repaired it and tent it again

Saturday Dec 30th commences with fine weather
middle and latter part the same saw a whale
ship to the windward all hands employd in
fishing cutinopendants and bending flying gib
and other ships duty load the boats for operating
the boats crew the same the night before
