September 6th 1915
The day sail from New Bedford for whaling voyage North Atlantic with 21 aft crew winds from SE light at sundown Course light bore or by N. 15 miles

Tuesday 7
with light SE winds foggy vessels under all sail heading S by E. 72 E. making in ship duty so end the day

Wednesday 8
The day with light winds and calm vessel under all sail heading nears Course lat 40.00 long 69.57

Thursday 9
The day with strong breeze East sea from NE vessel under short sail heading SE by S. No over sub

Friday 10
The day with strong breeze from NE. East sea vessel heading SE under short sail saw one steamer. So end the day
lat 36.50 long 65.44

Saturday 11
The day with fine weather winds from NE vessel under all sail heading E. SE. under all sail
lat 35.55 long 62.42

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
