- 19 Wednesday comes in light from the East in company with Swift-Nicholson, Nicholson quick Nicholson Lat 36-52 Long 73-30
- 20th Thurs. this day comes in from the S.W. and squally 3 whales in sight Lat 36-52 Long 74-00
- 21st Friday comes in fair from the Westward Lat 36-52 Long 74-00
- 22nd Saturday comes in from the South eight whales cruising Lat 36-52 Long 74-10
- 23rd Sunday comes in fair from the S.W. five whales in sight 4.5-3 Black fish and went on board of the Why come at 4 p.m. and spoke the Nicholson Run to the N.W. E. until 10 p.m. Lat 36-36
- 24th Monday comes in fresh breeze from the S.W. Run to the N.E. in company with the Nicholson at 4 p.m. jibed over bearing to the Westward Boreas B. Fish head Lat 37-04 Long 73-27
- 25 Tuesday comes in fresh breeze from the Eastward saw the Bk. cutting gave the Swift at 5 p.m. Hyland in sight Lat 37-11 Long 74-05
