Latter part hauled E. S. E. So was the day

- 27 Thurs. comes in with a breeze from the
Eastward and squally west-to-the
stream Lat-36-28
- 28 Friday comes in light N. E. this calm
and rain and six whales in sight
3634 74.05
- 29 Saturday comes in calm and
continues so all day. went on board of the
Bk. Capt. Gonsalves was there. Paritup the ship
- 30 Sunday comes in very light Westward
Capt. Smith was on board and got 3 men
coal sized not calm west on board
of the Nicholson Capt. Gonsalves was there
their Capt. Lopez of the Bk came on board
Lat-36-35 74-19 by Nicholson
- 31 Monday comes in light breeze N. E.
then calm remainder of day
Lat-36-44
- Aug. 1 Tuesday this day comes in light breeze
from the East raised whales and towers
in company with the Carlton Belle whales
going quick gave up chase at sunset
boats came aboard and carried all
sail all night B. D. Nicholson boiling
and chasing Swift and Nicholson
in sight Lat-36-44
- 2nd Wednesday this day comes in very
moderate Eastly Saw N. Nelson and Nicholson
with boats down they both got whales
lowered in boats and gave chase
but did not get near the whales
went on board of the Nicholson at 5 pm
Lat-37-18 Long 72-45
- 3rd Thursday comes in light from E. N. E.
Latter part the same

- Aug 4 Friday comes in light from the East
five whales in sight
Lat 37-37 Long 73-10
- 5 Saturday comes in light from the
East at 5 pm. went on board of the
Y. Goursey. C. 1 Bell in sight
Lat - Long
- 6 Sunday this day comes in with a
good breeze from the Eastward at 6 am
saw the C. Bell and Swift with boats down
in 15 the Southward raised the whales coming
to windward got in ahead of the whale
and lowered and the whale went on
and struck another whale got the line
in his jaw and the men came out
boat got stuck by lower whale boats
came aboard all vessels gave up
the chase in the stream then into
the N. E. and spoke the Nicholson at night
Lat-37-35 73-02
- 7th Monday this day comes in with a strong
breeze from the N. E. made sail and
at 7-30 all but Lawrence were refused
to men in went on board of the Nicholson
and at 10 a. m. the men all went in
work spoke the Nicholson at night
Lat 37-52 Long 73-45
- 8th Tuesday comes in light from the E. Capt.
Smith was on board at 5 a. m. and got
some coal Mac Salt and shot in the
S. E. both raised whales and raised whales
3 large men made with the Nicholson raised
more whales both of us got me out here
in area set the poles Long
Lat - Long
- 9th Wednesday comes in calm raised
whales close to ship gave up for them
and got 2 out this in Capt. Smith
came on board and they went
aboard of his vessel took in a sail
at sunset light breeze
Lat 37-48 Long 73-00
